 Z-22-06 Rezoning Town Center 53, LLC, by Mansoor Qamruddin, applicant and property owner, seeks to rezone 1.54 acre (Map/Parcel 120/013I) fronting approximately 200 feet on the east side of State Route 53 and 280 feet on the south side of Towne Center Parkway from C-2 (General Commercial Highway Oriented District) to C-3 (Commercial Motor Vehicles Service and Repair District). Proposed uses: convenience store with gasoline pumps, fast-food restaurant, and retail.
