BUSINESS ITEMS:

1. Time Capsule Update – Expect it to be dedicated on the same day as the clock is dedicated this year; exact date to be determined
2. Darby Building Update – Vogt has called Shepard 3 times without hearing from him (chasing him for materials to update) City Council wants to move the building to the Mulberry property though the funds allocated for it do not appear to be enough
3. Mural Project Status – Art council to be contacted for ideas on the mural content; looking for feedback right now as the funds have not been allocated.
4. Fundraising
 - Wine tasting event has been postponed from the initial June date to one in August.
 - Brick sales – have 100-150 bricks from the brick house demolished by the Kroger construction to use as a fundraiser
5. Historic Hoschton family storyboards – Tanner brought some of her family files to share and to be copied to begin our search for details about the Hosch founders of the city. Hopes are to share with the community in the future.
6. District creation – Vogt spoke with Matt Rupal and expressed the desire to create an historic district in hopes of saving historic properties from destruction. Strategic plan with time and funds needed.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Vogt has resigned as the clock project manager and handed the clock installation to the city maintenance group with the date to dedicate to be established hopefully in the first week of August

Harrison spoke to the committee requesting suggestions for decorations for 2 sides of the water tank being installed near Twin Lakes. Wants a slogan or historic image by Wednesday July 3rd.
