Permission to speak is at the discretion of the Mayor and City Council. Three (3) minutes will be allowed for each person chosen to speak. Grievances with individual employees may not be discussed. If you are selected to speak, you will be called upon by the presiding officer, and then shall come to the podium, state your name and address in the audible tone of voice for the record, and direct his/her remarks to the City Council as a body rather than to any particular member, limiting such remarks to no more than three (3) minutes.
